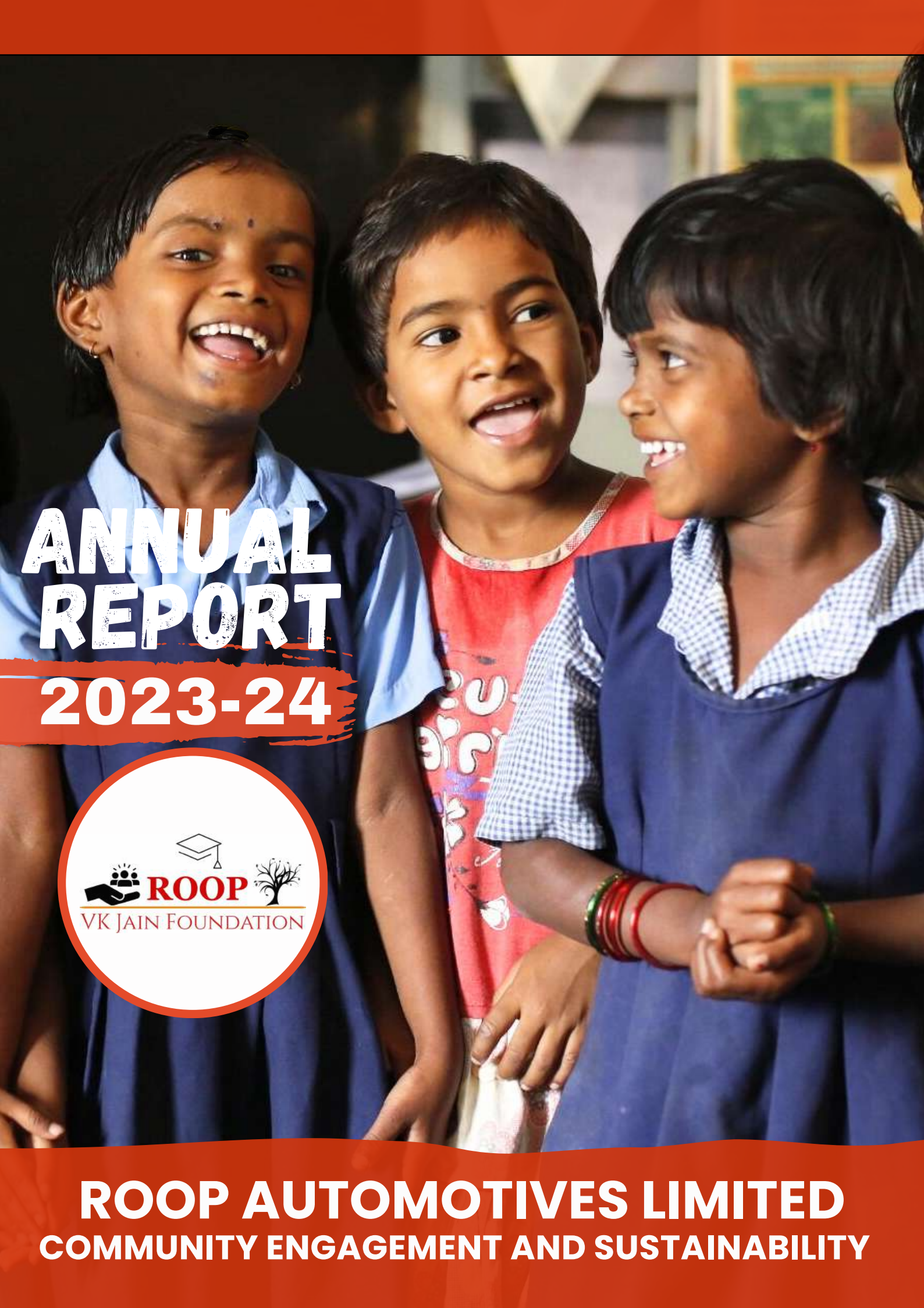

GENDER EQUALITY, ADOLESCENT SENSITIZATION, AND EMPOWERMENT

Implementation Partner

Through our program on Gender Equality, Adolescent Sensitization, and Empowerment with Cequin NGO, our mission is to empower adolescent girls and women and making a gender equitable community in Mewat. Through consistent engagement and interventions with adolescent girls, boys, and parents, we have witnessed a significant shift in attitudes and behaviors towards gender equality and women empowerment.

One notable achievement is the emergence of "Mardo wali Bat" discussions initiated by boys from Rozka, demonstrating their active engagement in promoting girls' safety and respect within the community. This initiative not only signifies a positive change in mindset but also lays the groundwork for fostering a more inclusive and equitable environment.

Approximately 130 girls from Rozka Meo are now actively participating in football, a traditionally male-dominated sport, on a regular basis. This not only promotes physical activity but also fosters confidence and self-esteem among these girls, empowering them to pursue their education and future aspirations with renewed vigor and determination.

"UNNATI" ON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

Our 3-year program "Unnati" focusing on Solid Waste Management in collaboration with Saahas, has successfully completed its 1st year of implementation. During the initial phase of our work, we implemented the project in Rozka Meo village, significantly enhancing the waste collection process across 450 households. Previously, there was no organized waste collection system in place, leading to indiscriminate disposal in landfills.

Through our collaboration with Saahas NGO, we introduced an effective waste management system to the village. Presently, waste from all 450 households is being collected regularly, with 70% of households actively participating in waste segregation. Additionally, we identified and repurposed an existing collection center provided by the Panchayat, which was previously unused. Following renovation, the center is now operational and serves as a hub for waste collection and segregation activities.

SAY-NO-TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Our project on "Hinsa ko No" has achieved significant milestones over the past year through our partnership with Radio Mewat and SMART NGO. This project is dedicated to raising awareness about domestic violence in the Nuh district of Mewat, Haryana, with a focus on empowering women to address and mitigate this pressing issue.

The "Hinsa ko No" initiative actively combats domestic violence against women by airing fresh episodes on Radio Mewat every week. Through these episodes, we strive to educate and inform the community about the various aspects of domestic violence and empower individuals to take action against it.



Additionally, the team from SMART NGO plays a crucial role in engaging with women in the community through narrowcasting and group meetings. During these sessions, women are educated about domestic violence and provided with information on how to seek help and support. This includes guidance on accessing resources such as the nearest police station, Radio Mewat, and the Mahila Helpline, empowering them to address and resolve instances of domestic violence effectively.

Our program "Pankh" a comprehensive Training Program on "Menstrual Hygiene Management" and the distribution of hygiene care packs in nearby villages of IMT Manesar, in partnership with Rann Foundation, has successfully completed its 1st year. Through this initiative, we have empowered and educated 5000 girls and women about menstrual hygiene, recognizing its critical importance in women's health.

The goal of this project is to increase girls' awareness about menstrual health and safe practices so that it can increase overall menstrual and reproductive health, reduce barriers that prevent girls from attending school, and increase their quality of life.

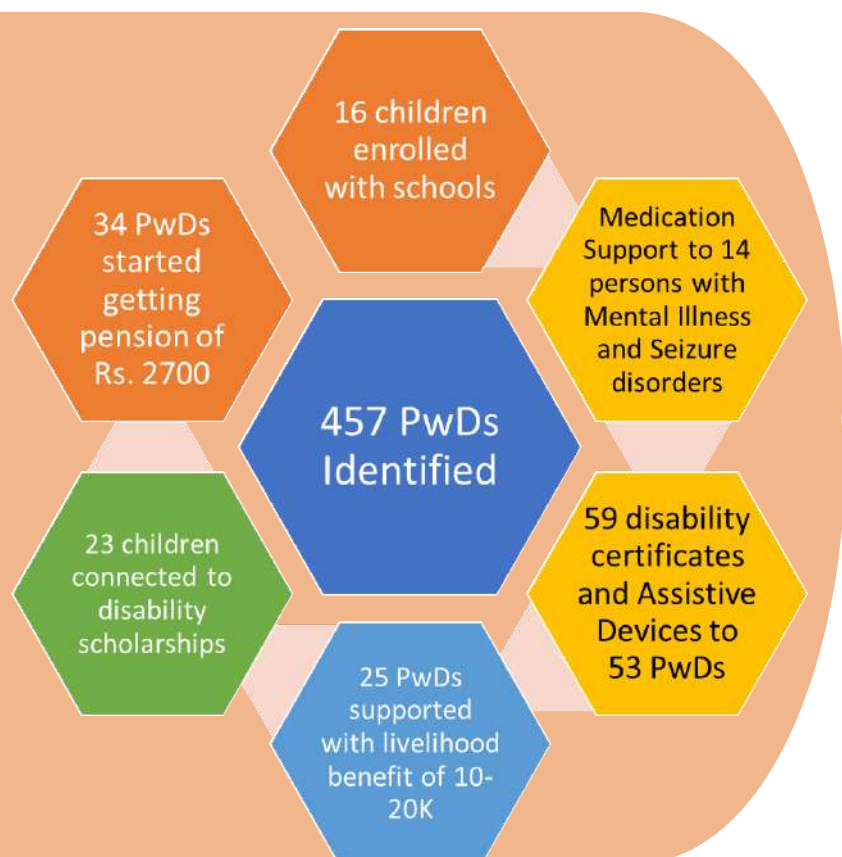
COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS

Our project on Community-Based Rehabilitation for Differently Abled Persons, in collaboration with Caritas NGO, is currently active in 12 villages of Nuh, Mewat, Haryana. The primary objective of this project is to empower and support 450 differently abled individuals identified within these communities. Through consistent interventions, our aim is to enable them to achieve self-sufficiency and lead fulfilling lives.

Through regular intervention our team is assisting them in gaining independence, facilitating proper documentation necessary for eligibility for government schemes, connecting them with pensions, and aiding them in obtaining disability certificates. Additionally, we are committed to enhancing their livelihood opportunities and ensuring access to quality healthcare, education, and dignity.

This program was launched in collaboration with the Rann Foundation focused on educating the communities near Dharuhera about Hepatitis B & C. Our goal is to reach and educate as many individuals as possible through this initiative. This project is dedicated to combating viral hepatitis in Dharuhera by increasing awareness, promoting sanitation practices, delivering essential healthcare services, and minimizing risky behaviors through community involvement and vaccination campaigns. EDUCATION SUPPORT TO SLUM CHILDREN

Our ongoing support for Utsav Foundation in providing quality education to slum children continues. This year, with the support of PK Salhotra Family, we introduced a digital literacy lab for the children.

On October 13th, 2023, inauguration of the computer lab, "Ankuram," in memory of our founder director, Late Shri PK Salhotra, was conducted in the presence of the Hon'ble Governor of Haryana, Shri Bandaru Dattatreya Ji. This lab offers a variety of courses, both short and long-term, including Python, Java, C++, and Photoshop, with a special focus on block coding and AI-Robotics for underprivileged children. Implemented by Utsav Foundation, this lab is currently benefiting over 180 children.



In addition to this, our project free education support is assisting over 350 slum children in accessing quality education. Implementation Partner Utsav Foundation.



SCHOOL + PROGRAM

Over the past two years, we've dedicated ourselves to enhancing the literacy levels of children enrolled in government schools. These students often encounter obstacles in their learning journey due to a lack of proper guidance. Consequently, they struggle with subjects like Math, Hindi, English and Tamil. To bridge this educational divide, we introduced our specialized School+ program, in collaboration with our implementation partner, the Vilvam Foundation in Tiruvannamalai, Chennai.

Throughout the financial year 2023-2024, we successfully operated eight learning centers, catering to approximately 400 children from underprivileged backgrounds. In addition to academic support, we prioritized providing these children with exposure to digital literacy. We established a fully functional computer center, offering computer classes to empower these young learners.

Our project plays a pivotal role in helping children identify and address their learning gaps. As a result, not only has the literacy rate improved, but we've also observed a decline in dropout rates among children attending government schools in our targeted area.



Higher Education support: Contribution to make young lives shine Implementation Partner-Udayan Care

Our support to provide higher education and quality living to 10 young adults enrolled at GD Goenka University, Sohna, in collaboration with Udayan Care Children's Home, continues. This initiative aims to provide these students with higher education and a better quality of life.

This year, 5 of these young adults have successfully completed their higher education and embarked on their professional journeys through internships and jobs. Their achievements demonstrate that given the right opportunities, they are just as capable as anyone else, often exceeding expectations with their outstanding results.



HEALTH AND SAFETY FOR WOMEN



Our monthly medicine support for the Rehoboth-Shelter, dedicated to mentally challenged women, for the past 2 years is continues. Located in Chennai, the shelter has provided refuge to approximately 300 women rescued from distressing circumstances. Many of the women under the care of Rehoboth-Shelter have endured traumatic experiences, leading to their mental health challenges. Recognizing the critical need for medical attention.

Through consistent medication and proper shelter facilities, these women have shown remarkable progress in overcoming their past traumas and improving their mental well-being.

Beyond medication, we have implemented a holistic approach to rehabilitation, incorporating regular counseling sessions and therapeutic activities into their daily routines. These initiatives aim to address not only their medical needs but also their emotional and psychological well-being.

Warisha From Gazarpur village Nuh

Warisha, a 34-year-old woman from Gazarpur village, Nuh, faced tough times with her 70% disability and caring for her five children while her husband was jobless. Caritas India noticed her interest in goat rearing during a survey and, with support from Roop VK Jain Foundation, helped her start her own goat business. Warisha shared that she is now able to earn some money for her family and support her children. She expressed her heartfelt thanks to the team.



Pinki from Atta village, Nuh

Pinki, a 25-year-old girl from the village Atta, Nuh faced challenges due to her hearing impairment, living with her aunt after losing both her parents. Under our project run by Caritas India, Pinki learned sewing and stitching despite her disability. With financial aid, Pinki now runs her own stitching center and has her own income. She is grateful for the support provided by the Roop VK Jain Foundation.



Vikas from Indri village, Nuh

Vikas, a 20-year-old boy from Indri village, Nuh, faced a significant challenge when he lost his leg due to a kabaddi injury in 2017. Despite this setback, he remained determined to support his family. Recognizing his computer skills, we provided financial aid for a Computer Service Centre, offering a viable income source compatible with Vikas's physical limitations. This assistance addressed Vikas's immediate livelihood needs, empowering him to become self-reliant despite his challenges.



IMPACT STORIES

Ruhida from Chepera village, Nuh

Ruhida, a 36-year-old from village Chapera, encountered several hardships due to her locomotor disability. With her husband unemployed, providing support for her children and family was a struggle. Ruhida expressed a desire to begin a duck farming venture. With the backing of the Roop VK Jain Foundation, Ruhida's dream became a reality, enabling her to financially support her family.



Hansira from Rozka Meo village, Nuh

Hansira, a 29-year-old from Rojkameo village, Nuh, confronted obstacles due to her locomotor disability. Despite this, with a BA degree and computer proficiency, she aimed to support her family and defy societal norms. With our assistance, she bought a printer and computer to set-up a small shop nearby her home to provide services like online applications, printing and Photocopy. Hansira contributes to her community and finds joy in her self-employment.



Bilkis from Basai village, Nuh

Bilkis, a 38-year-old woman from Basai village, Nuh, confronted hurdles with her 70% locomotor disability and her husband's illness, rendering him unable to work. Despite these challenges, she aspired to purchase a buffalo to create income by selling milk. Acknowledging her resolve and the prospect of self-sufficiency, we extended our support to kickstart her dream. With our support, Bilkis embarked on her path towards financial independence.



IMPACT STORIES

Payal, 11th grade-Govt. School Manesar

I learned a lot from this program like how our food should be during menstruation. How to keep cleanliness and in how much time the sanitary pad should be changed is an important topic. It was very beneficial for me to join this project, most of the girls do not tell their problems related to menstruation to anyone, so it was good for them to join this project.

I was impressed with this program because there was no talk on a topic like menstruation before, there was no one to share my problems. Now there is a lot to be learned in every session, all the stigma associated with it should be broken, we are getting sanitary pads, soap, Paste & Gel, which are very beneficial in menstrual hygiene



Nasima: An Anganwadi Parent, Rozka Meo, Nuh

Nasima, a mother of four children from Rozka Meo Village, initially faced trouble as her children were irregular in attending the Anganwadi center. She shared that after the interventions by Roop and SRF, there are better provisions for health, hygiene, and educational facilities. Her children now regularly attend the Anganwadi. As a frequent visitor to the Anganwadi center, Nasima has noticed a significant improvement in the quality of education and the overall facilities provided.



IMPACT STORIES

Rahul from Puthur, TamilNadu

Ragul, a 5th-grade student from a government school in Puthur, faced bullying due to his stammer, resulting in low self-confidence. A year ago, he barely spoke when he joined the center. His father, a daily wage worker, couldn't afford therapy. Thanks to the patient guidance of VKC teacher Ms. Sindhukavi, Ragul is now a confident, eager learner who reads and speaks in front of the class. His parents' express gratitude for nurturing his growth and self-esteem.



Madhu (name changed), Firozpur Jhirka, Nuh

A 24-year-old woman was trapped in an abusive marriage with her husband, who gambled and neglected her. Her father-in-law also mistreated her, hoping she would leave. The Radio Mewat team learned of her plight and invited her to share her story.

Through continuous interaction and counseling, they persuaded her husband and father-in-law to change their ways. Grateful for the support, Madhu now lives peacefully with her family.

Soniya, 12 years old, from Rozka Meo, Nuh

No one in my family is educated. Our community, including my family, believes that educating girls threatens their honor. We are forced to wear scarves at a young age and not allowed to run, play, or jump. My brother gets pure milk while I get a cup of tea. But I think differently. I noticed gender discrimination in my own family.

Last year, I learned about the Gender Equality Project run by CEQUIN and supported by the Roop VK Jain Foundation. My mother and I joined the parents' group, and I started attending meetings with her. This inspired me to join the football program. I enrolled and felt proud to step out of the four walls of my home and enjoy some freedom.

Today, I am in a leadership role and have seen a significant change in my family, where girls used to be so restricted. Now, my father, brother, and grandfather come to drop me off at the football ground.
